

Pronouns

A **pronoun** is a word that takes the place of a noun.

Subject pronouns can be the subject of a sentence. For example: *They* are going to the store.

Subject Pronouns						
I	we	you	he	she	it	they

Object pronouns follow an action verb or words such as *to*, *with*, *for*, or *at*. For example: Dinita helps *her* a lot.

Object Pronouns						
me	us	you	him	her	it	them

Possessive pronouns are pronouns that show ownership or belonging. For example: Blanca showed Carlos *her* favorite beach.

Possessive Pronouns						
my	your	her	his	its	our	their

Intensive pronouns add emphasis to the subject of a sentence. For example: I did the work *myself*.

Intensive Pronouns						
myself	yourself	herself	himself	itself	ourselves	themselves
